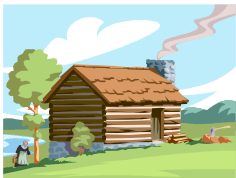


Missions Conference

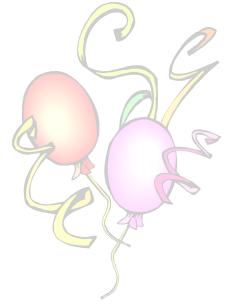

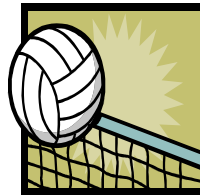
